### Xi'an Jiaotong-Liverpool University (XJTLU)

University of Liverpool students have the opportunity to study for either one or two semesters at XJTLU, during the penultimate year of your degree.

**Xi’an Jiaotong-Liverpool University** is a Sino-British institution, jointly founded by Xi'an Jiaotong University and the University of Liverpool, located in Suzhou, China.

Founded in 2006 with an initial intake of just 164 students, the University has grown rapidly over the last six years. We now have nearly 6,000 students on campus with a further 1,600 studying at Liverpool under a 2+2 articulation agreement. We also have 350 academic staff members from 40 countries.

University of Liverpool Exchange Students are registered onto a degree programme which normally mirrors the programme offered at the University of Liverpool. The programme you study will be a direct transfer from your programme at the University of Liverpool.

Students also have the option to study Mandarin Chinese for up to 5 credits per semester. In addition to four hours of classes per week, you will also be assigned a Chinese Language Partner to help enhance your learning.

## Suzhou, China

Suzhou is one of China’s most historically interesting and culturally dynamic, modern cities. Along with its rich history of over 2,500 years, the prominence of large companies in Suzhou Industrial Park (SIP) has brought with it a rapid growth in the expat community.

Suzhou is now the fourth largest economy in China, with a GDP of over RMB 1 trillion (approx. GBP 10 billion) in 2011. Despite its close proximity, Suzhou residents can enjoy a much lower living cost than that in neighbouring Shanghai, which is located just 25 minutes away by high-speed train.

Suzhou is perfectly suited for international students, with excellent sports facilities around campus, a variety of shopping malls, cinemas and restaurants located around the scenic Jinji Lake, and an expanding choice of bars and nightclubs.
