ASCII Character Set

Requirements

Produce a Python program that outputs the 128 ASCII (American Standard Code for Information Interchange) character set from 0 to 127 (inclusive).

The ASCII character set was a 7-but code devised for use with teleprinters. The original ASCII code was developed under the auspices of the American Standards Association and was published in 1963. Note that 33 of the 128 ASCII character codes are non-printing control characters (many now obsolete). For example:

7 = Beep

9 = Horizontal tab

10 = Line feed

(carriage return)

27 = Escape 32 = Space 127 = Delete
